Applications to exhibit in the SCH Art Space 0 in 2012 are NOW OPEN to all FoNAS Members. The Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick is about "celebrating life". Hospitals around the world recognise the significant role art plays in the healing environment. Art has an important intellectual, social and spiritual role in our lives but also has the power to lift our emotions, make us smile, and keep us calm in times of stress.

The Arts Curator at the Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick has worked alongside Friends of the National Art School to present a rotating exhibition program, providing artists with a unique platform for exposure, creating an environment that is culturally stimulating and diverse for patients, staff and visitors. The FoNAS Art Space is located on level 0 of the SCH (which has over 50,000 visitors per annum), providing one significant space (measuring over 60m long) suitable for exhibiting 2-dimensional media such as painting, photography, printmaking, textiles & drawing.

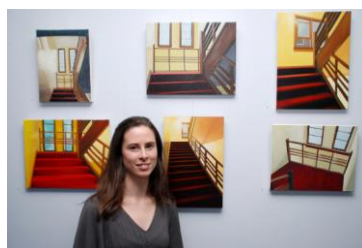
Please note if there is interest from more than one artist for a particular rotation, then joint shows may be suggested with agreement from successful applicants.

Information for Artists

OVERVIEW:

- Applicants must be a financial member of FONAS and pay a non refundable \$25 application fee. Exhibiting Artists will be selected by representatives from FONAS and the SCH Foundation. Selection panel's decision is final and no subsequent discussion will be entered into.
- Applicants are required to accept all the conditions of the art exhibition space as set out by the FONAS and Sydney Children's Hospital Foundation. Art works must be suitable for a children's hospital environment. Work must not be disturbing, and must **not exhibit explicit nudity**.
- Artworks must be **hanging ready** i.e. framed or mounted with D-rings to suit the Hospital's Curtrax™ system. Works that are unmounted or require preparation for hanging will not be accepted.

THE EXHIBITION

- It is the responsibility for the exhibitor to arrange the hanging and dismantling of the exhibition. The SCHF curator will be available to assist with this. Hanging of all exhibitions take place on Tuesdays (9am – 3pm) prior to the Thursday Opening.
- FONAS and SCH Foundation will take reasonable care in handling work but accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any work whilst on FONAS or SCHF property and costs related to damage to property of SCHF is to be met by the exhibitor. The SCHF **is not responsible for insurance** of the artworks while in transit or in situ at the Sydney Children's Hospital.
- There is no exhibition fee for the space however the Sydney Children's Hospital Foundation Arts Curator will select a work(s) from each artist to be included in the Hospital's Collection, in agreement with the artist at the conclusion of the exhibition. A 15% Buyer's Commission is also included in the Sale Price to cover SCHF Administration Costs.

PUBLICITY & THE INVITATION

- Design and cost of invitation will be arranged by the SCHF. The Foundation requires a HIGH-QUALITY Digital Image of 1 artwork and the TITLE of the EXHIBITION **6 weeks prior to the Exhibition Opening**.
- SCH Foundation will arrange for details of the exhibition to be distributed throughout the hospital, via email and mail, and will include a Facebook page for each exhibition (see www.facebook.com "Sydney Childrens Hospital Art Program"). FONAS will also distribute exhibition notice via fortnightly e-Bulletin to members. FONAS can supply artists with a template for an Arts Press Release (based on the SCHF Arts Release); artists are asked to supply FONAS and the SCHF with a final draft before release to the media.

THE OPENING

- Is to be arranged with SCHF, held on Thursday nights and are to be held between 5.30 – 7.30pm. Openings to take place on Level 0, refreshments and drinks served in the BigPond Café. SCHF to provide catering and alcohol
- SCHF to supply the alcohol for the opening via Lion Nathan sponsorship. Artists to arrange guest speaker and advise SCHF& FONAS. SCHF will help set up the Opening; and FONAS will support in terms of photography as available.

SALES

- All sales of artworks will be managed by the SCHF Art Curator. **Artists are advised to note that the Foundation will add 15% Buyer's Commission in the advertised price.**
- The SCHF will request all buyers to arrange pick up of purchased works at the exhibition's closure. Artists are responsible for the pick-up of all unsold works.
- Artists will be paid upon the completion of the exhibition, pending the completion of processing and approval of all sales documentation. Payment will be by EFT payment only.

PRO BONO WORKSHOPS in the ARTIX PROGRAM

- All artists are invited to work with the SCH's Play Therapy Department to undertake workshops. SCHF to liaise with artists and Play Therapy about availability and workshop delivery. Workshops will consist of a two-hour session during a designated School Holiday.
