General Information

The St Vincent's Campus Art Committee's was established in 2003 with an aim to consider, develop and promote application of the humanities with a strong emphasis on fine arts within St Vincent's Hospitals. The committee have worked alongside Friends of the National Art School to present a rolling program of exhibitions in Xavier Art Space providing artists with a unique platform for exposure, creating an environment that is culturally stimulating and diverse for patients, staff and visitors. Each year there are exhibitions by FONAS members who have applied to present in the space as well as shows for National Art School student prize winners.

St Vincent's Hospital, Xavier Art Space is located on levels 3 & 4 which provide two spaces suitable for exhibiting media such as painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, mixed media sculpture and ceramics.

Xavier Level 3 is suitable for framed works, as well as 3D works.

Xavier Level 4 consists of 25 mounted perspex panels suitable for unframed works.

Commission is taken in the form of one work from each exhibiting artist to be selected for inclusion in the St Vincent's Hospital Art Collection

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Applicants must be a financial member of FONAS and pay a \$25 application fee.
- Exhibiting Artists will be selected by representatives from FONAS and St Vincent's Campus Art Committee.
- Applicants are required to accept all the conditions of the art exhibition space as set out by the FONAS and St Vincent's Campus Art Committee.
- Art works must be suitable for the hospital environment and enhance health and healing at St Vincent's Hospital.
- Art work must be in line with requirements of the Sisters of Charity. Work must not be disturbing, and must not exhibit nudes. Art work must be suitable for the hospital environment and enhance health and healing at St Vincent's.
- Invitation and catering expenses are the responsibility of selected artists.
- Car parking facilities are available at St Vincent's Hospital, Victoria St, Darlinghurst for delivery and collection.
- The St Vincent's Campus Art Committee will select from each exhibition one work by the exhibiting artist to add to the St Vincent's Hospital Art Collection.
- Sales of works of art will be managed by Katarina Cvitkovic of the St Vincent's Campus Art committee, including the collection of proceeds.
- Exhibitor is able to arrange posters, which can be displayed throughout the hospital.
- Exhibitor may arrange for advertising, at own expense, in consultation with the Public Relations Officer.
- The Art Committee will arrange for details of the exhibition to be distributed throughout the campus, via email and mail. An article will also appear in the campus magazine "Pulse", if publication dates coincide with that of the exhibition start date.
- Friends of the NAS will also distribute exhibition notice via email to members.
- Selection panel's decision is final and no subsequent discussion will be entered into.
- All works must be for sale.
- All work must be ready for exhibition and have identifying information attached (including artist's name, work title, medium, dimensions in cm and price).
- It is the responsibility for the exhibitor to arrange the hanging and dismantling of the exhibition
- Friends of the National Art School and St Vincent's Art Committee will take reasonable care in handling work but accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any work whilst on Friends of the National Art School or St Vincent's Art Committee property.
- It should be noted that the exhibitions will not be manned.
- Artists accept responsibility for all transport, unpacking and repacking matters, including costs in the delivery and collection of works.
- Costs related to damage to property of St Vincent's Hospital is to be met by the exhibitor.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to arrange for sold works of art to be delivered to the buyer. Buyer details will be provided by Members of the Art Committee.
- Compliance with Liquor Act guidelines and responsible service of alcohol is required during opening night functions.
- Functions are to end no later than 8:00pm if held on hospital premises.
